Scripture Reading: Luke 13:1-5

What does it mean to repent?

1. Repentance involves changing your mind about your sinfulness.

Repentance is the sinner agreeing with the righteous condemnation of the Law. It is the sinner agreeing that not only his conduct but his heart is evil and rebellious and contrary to God and His law.

Repentance is simply agreeing with God's diagnosis of our depravity and understanding that we are helpless to do anything about it.

2. Repentance means acknowledging Jesus Christ as the only Savior.

It is a turning 180 degrees. It is turning from sin to something and the something or someone is always Christ.

True repentance is a point in time change of mind that has linear results as there is evidence provided of the change in one's conduct moving away from sin and to obedience.
