- 1. Believe in Jesus.
 - Cite John 20:30
 - Quote: "True belief does not simply mean believing Jesus, that is, believing that he is telling the truth and is not speaking lies. Rather, the work God requires is this: to believe in the one he has sent. Or as Jesus says elsewhere, "He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. To believe, then, is to rely completely on his person and to trust totally what he teaches about himself. True believers see Jesus for who he says he is, and they rely on him." - Mark Dever
- 2. Worship the God of Heaven, not the Heaven of God
- 3. What we need in troubles is truth
- 4. We should ask Jesus for powerful and effective ministry
